



Foodbanks work with frontline professionals



- health visitors
- social workers
- Citizens Advice.

### Receive voucher

These workers can provide vouchers for emergency food

# Receive support

The food bank + referral agency collect basic information to help understand how to offer the right support

# Vouchers = 3 days emergency food

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Many foodbanks (not all) take vouchers in exchange for food.

#### **BUS PASS**

The National Entitlement Card (NEC)

Free or cheaper travel to

- young people
- older people (60+)
- people with a disability





The NEC card =

- free bus travel across Scotland, and trams (issued by the City of Edinburgh Council)
- Cards with **C**+ allow a companion to travel free
- People with visual impairments can get free train and cheaper ferry travel.



Railcard

eligible for Disabled Persons Railcard if you:

- receive Personal Independence Payments (PIP)
- receive Disability Living Allowance (DLA) at either:
- the higher or lower rate for the mobility component, or
- the higher or middle rate for the care component
- have a visual impairment

80% or more disability

- have a hearing impairment
- have epilepsy
- receive Attendance Allowance or Severe
- Disablement Allowance
- receive War Pensioner's Mobility Supplementreceive War or Service Disablement Pension for
  - buy or lease a vehicle through the Motability scheme

**Taxicard** 



A taxicard could be an option if your disability makes getting buses difficult.

Lasts for three years for 104 trips per year Eligibility- live in Edinburgh and have a permanent disability

Central Taxis are the only taxi operator who accepts taxicards.

City Cabs offer a Cab Assist Card.

If you're a Taxi Card user or are over the age of 65 then you're eligible for the City
